Hare Krishna! Welcome to New Vrindaban for our transcendently opulent festival in honor of Lord Sri Krishna's Appearance Day and our Spiritual Master's Vyasa Puja celebration.

The festival here is on Saturday, Sunday and Monday (August 10 - 12). There will be many activities and events scheduled throughout the 3 days and a Janmastami Festival Program Schedule will be posted at the guest reception room and other places on the farm. A booth will be set up, selling milk sweets, ice cream, japa beads, photographs of New Vrindaban dhama, Deity pictures, etc., and Indian clothing. Name tags will be issued at the reception room and we are asking for a modest \$5.00 a day donation to help cover our expenses.

Water for drinking will be available in the temple greenhouse and provided in marked barrels. Stool houses are located behind the temple building and next to the new barn site. There is a dispensary for any emergency medical needs. As for sleeping accommodations and shower facilities, please inquire at the reception desk.

Because of a sensitive position with some of our neighbors, please do not trespass on other property. If you would like to tour our New Vrindaban farm and property, take an experienced New Vrindaban resident with you.

Everyone, during their stay here, is requested to follow the four regulative principles for spiritual life (no meat eating, no intoxication, no illicit sex--sex outside of marriage or for any reason other than procreation, and no gambling), and to abide by the rules of the community (trespassing policy, passing stool and urine only at prescribed places, etc.). Anyone not following these regulations or causing a disturbance will face immediate expulsion from the community.

In case of need the following people are in charge of the major departments: Kirtanananda Swami - Siksaguru, Parambrahma das - General Manager, Mahendra das - Program Director, Urdhareta das - Medical and Defense Captain; traffic and parking; women personal problems, Sudanu das - Head Cook, Narada Muni das and Aksobhya das - Krishna Bol.

On the back of this supplement sheet are the temple program and prasadam and feast serving schedules. So please, we humbly beg all of you to cooperate whole-heartedly with everyone so that Sri Krishna's Janmastami Festival will be transcendently pleasing to the Supreme Personality of Godhead and His devotees. Let us all relish this most auspicious occasion, and certainly if we maintain our eternal Krishna Consciousness, there will be no room for the anxiety of material consciousness.
